⅓ cinnamon stick

2 table spoons (30 mL) sugar

4 ounces (120mL) vodka ½ cup (60mL) fresh orange iuice

Instructions:

Place Bigelow® "Constant Comment" tea bags into a measuring cup and add 1¼ cups boiling water and cinnamon stick, let brew five minutes. Remove tea bags and cinnamon stick, add sugar and stir until it dissolves. Chill.

To make Cosmo, mix 2 ounces of the cooled sweet tea with 1 ounce vodka and 1 tablespoon orange juice in a cocktail shaker with ice. Shake well and strain into a martini glass, garnish with a strip of orange zest and cinnamon stick if desired.

Yield: Serves 4.
