You may never have thought about it, but the most used appliance in your kitchen is likely the sink. That said, you want to get a sink that suits you. For example, single basins give you more room, double basins more flexibility. Next, how does it look? Sink and faucet should work well together.

Then there's the material. The most popular is stainless steel. It's heat, stain and chip resistant but it can scratch and show fingerprints. To help, there's now a specially finished stainless steel that's scratch and fingerprint resistant and twice as strong as conventional stainless steel. Called Durinox, it was developed by Blanco, one of the world's leading providers of high-quality kitchen sinks and faucets.
