MANY OLDER ADULTS AND THOSE WHO CARE FOR THEM TURN TO THE ELDERCARE LOCATOR—A PROGRAM OF THE ADMINISTRATION ON AGING, AN AGENCY OF THE ADMINISTRATION FOR COMMUNITY LIVING—FOR ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE.

BY CONNECTING OLDER ADULTS AND THEIR CAREGIVERS TO LOCAL RESOURCES AND SUPPORT, THE ELDERCARE LOCATOR CONNECTS THEM TO HELP IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITIES WHERE THEY CAN FIND INFORMATION ON ACCESSIBLE TRANSPORTATION, MEDICATION SAFETY, HELP IN THE HOME, LIVING WITH DEMENTIA AND MORE.
