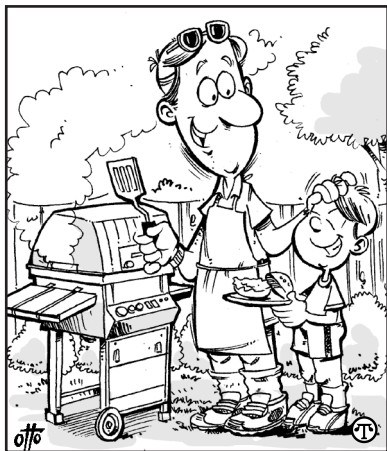




A New Vacation At The Old Address
