- Teenagers or others drive your van? Fear not. Safe driving habits can be promoted and driver distractions limited with the Chrysler KeySense programmable key fob. Using a four-digit security PIN programmed via the touch screen, an assigned key fob limits speed and audio volume and mutes the audio until front seat belts are buckled.
