Reasons for more frequent oil changes may include:

• Stop-and-go driving (trips that are less than 10 miles),

- Driving in dust or sand,
- Cold weather operation,
- Extended high speeds,

• Idling for extended periods, and

• Frequent cold starts and short trips. Trailer towing also may require a shorter interval between oil changes.

Some older vehicles are a quart low at the 3,000 mile mark. If the driver doesn't add a quart of oil, the engine's oil consumption will

begin to accelerate. For example, if the car is not serviced until the 5,000 mile mark, it already could be 2.5 or so quarts low on oil. Many \$4,000 engines have been replaced because the engine was run low on oil. In some cases, the sticker showed that the car was past due for an oil change.
