seven years, his local efforts grew into “Friends for Life of America,” a worldwide initiative involving 50,000 college students working with pediatric cancer patients.

Recently, Cohen was honored for his efforts by the Volvo for Life Awards, a nationwide search for and celebration of local heroes. Award organizers are now looking for more nominees.

Judges will select nine finalists. Three will each receive \$50,000 to be donated to the charities of their choice. Six will each receive a \$25,000 charitable donation.
