the Wild Things Are," "The Three Robbers" will spook and excite the imagination of children ages 4 and up. The book was also just recently made into an animated film.

An enchanting woven sequence of engaging text and unforgettable illustrations tells the story of three black-clad robbers who hold up a carriage only to find an orphan inside who is on her way to live with a wicked aunt. Quite unexpectedly, the robbers are charmed by the little girl and she inspires them to use their riches for good.
