(NAPSA)—Lovers of steamy romance—with humor and mystery thrown in—are sure to enjoy two new books from two of America’s best-selling authors.

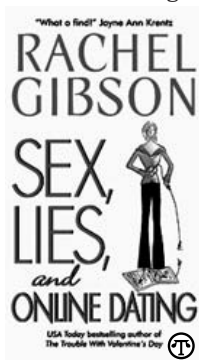
“The Barefoot Princess” (Avon, \$7.99) by Christina Dodd is the second passionate, hilarious, his-
