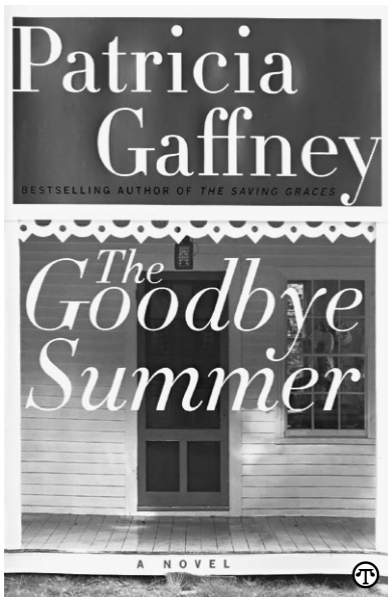




More Than A Summer Read
