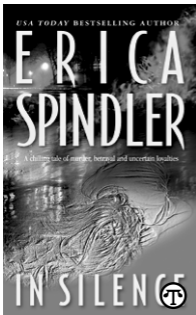




Terrific Twisted Tales

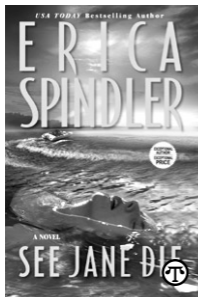
