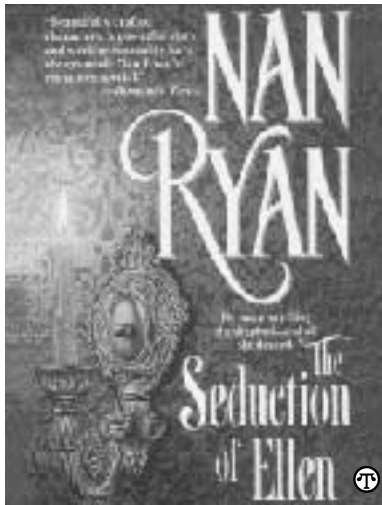


Love Happens In Strange Places
