(Plume), follows McCarthy as she discovers an intense combination of behavioral therapy, diet and supplements that became the key to saving her son.

With sheer determination, sweat, tears and controversial (but proven) methods, McCarthy has dramatically improved her son's diagnosis; he currently attends a mainstream school, interacting with children and adults as if he were a typical kid.

Autism currently affects one in 150 children. The book sheds much-needed light on autism through McCarthy's own heartbreak and struggle, and provides an ultimately hopeful example of how parents can shape their children's lives and happiness.
