


## BOOKS WORTH READING



Raised by his Scottish Presbyterian family on a North Carolina dairy farm, William Franklin Jr. was known as "a nice kid, a good boy, typical and average." When he was 17, a revival meeting in Charlotte, North Carolina sparked a change, but it wasn't until he took a nighttime walk on a golf course that an inner, irresistible urge caused him to sink to his knees and sob, "Oh God, if You want me to serve You, I will. I'll be what You want me to be. I'll go where You

want me to go." And after that, Billy Graham's life was never the same.
