

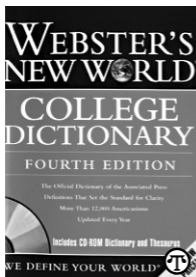

## Live And Learn

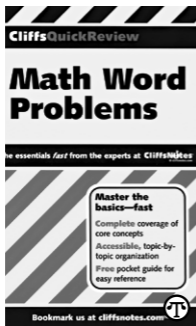
(NAPSA)—Whether you're preparing for college or just want to keep your mind sharp, these reference books belong on your bookshelf.
