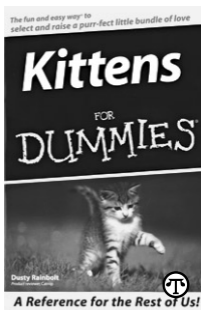




Pet Pointers In Print

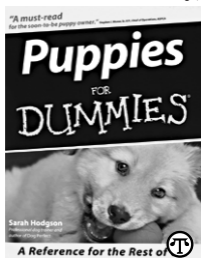
