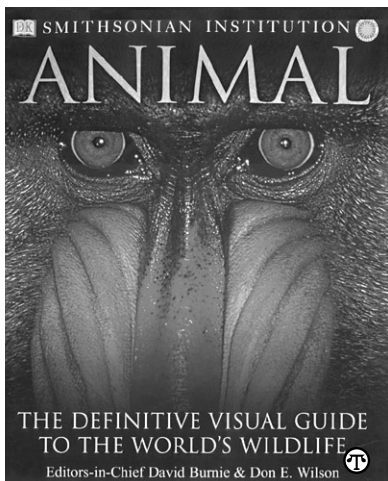




Understanding Animals
