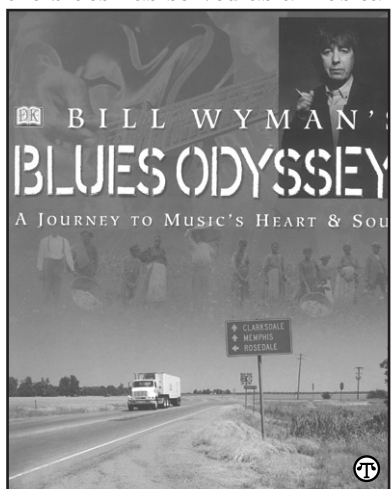

## Former Rolling Stone Pens Blues Tribute

and spiritual inspiration, both on and off the stage.

Now he pays tribute to the blues and the people who made the music in a book he describes as a labor of love. Said Wyman, "I wanted the opportunity to tell people more about why I love this music and to share with them its heritage."

*Bill Wyman's Blues Odyssey* (DK Publishing \$40.00) follows the growth of blues music as it spread from the Mississippi Delta to the world.

It also tells the story of an art form that has been an expression of love and faith in the face of hard times and that eventually gave birth to rock 'n' roll.

Filled with photographs, interviews and commentary, the book contains biographies and guides to the essential recordings and most influential artists—as well as the occasional nod to the exploits of the Rolling Stones.
