The Equal Justice Works (formerly NAPIL) Fellowships Program was launched in 1992 to address the shortage of attorneys working on behalf of traditionally under-served populations and causes in the United States.

Each fellowship has three components:

- A carefully designed initiative that involves legal advocacy on behalf of individuals, groups or issues that are not adequately represented.
- Working on this initiative is a third-year law student, recent law graduate or experienced attorney with a demonstrated commitment to public interest law who has the relevant skills and initiative to carry out the goals of the project.
- Employment by a host organization, which provides training, supervision, benefits and other support.
