Entrants selected for the program, sponsored by the National Association of Black Journalists (NABJ) and Heineken USA, will travel to Miami in August to report on the event.

From Miami, students selected to participate in the program will file news reports for radio stations in their local markets and receive special instruction from news pro-

fessionals from the NABJ.

How To Apply

To apply for Heineken: On Assignment, applicants must be 21 years of age or older by August 5, 2002, submit a 10 minute or shorter demo cassette tape of their best work in radio (can be news, features, interviews of documentaries), along with a cover letter describing their interest in pursuing a career in journalism. A brief description of the tape's content is also recommended. Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical trade school and be available for travel to Miami August 5 - 10.
