New enhancements also include an even wider selection of paper, such as cardstock, pastel, bright, résumé and executive papers.

Expanded shipping features have been added as well, including the option to select ground services in addition to express, and the ability to pay for shipping

using FedEx account numbers. Also, package tracking numbers are now provided in the order completion e-mail.
