## Popular Characters Help Educate Via CD-ROM

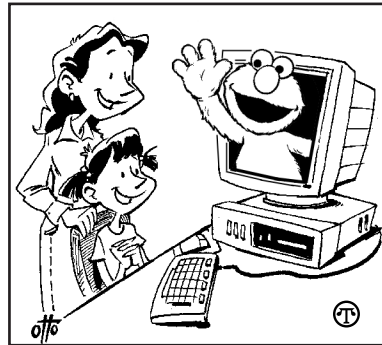
(NAPS)—Some of the beloved characters from a pair of educational television shows are now putting in an appearance on home computers—just in time for the holidays.
