



Information “Portals” That Integrate Any Data

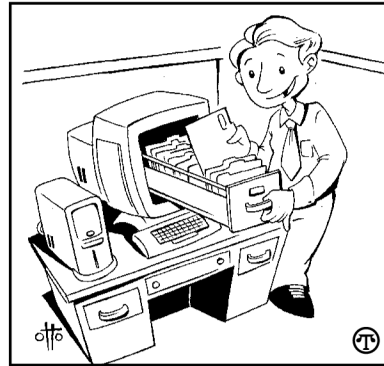
