## **NFL Coach Contest Earns Supplies For Schools**

(NAPSA)—A program that benefits schools and honors professional football coaches is kicking off its sixth season.

Sponsored in partnership with the National Football League (NFL) and CBS Sports, the "Staples Coach of the Week program" will award each of 17 accredited K-12 schools a \$5,000 gift certificate and a visit from the head coach of their region's NFL team.
