## Help Protect The Health Of Your Family And The Earth

Here are hints that can help:

2. Get crafty and recycle or upcycle paper, cardboard and tins into new household items. Instead of throwing away your empty box of cereal, cut it into a magazine holder or mail filer. Just finished that last scoop of coffee grinds from the tin? Make a decorative container out of it to store other kitchen odds and ends.

3. Replace paper towels with old T-shirts to wipe down surfaces and windows without leaving waste behind.
