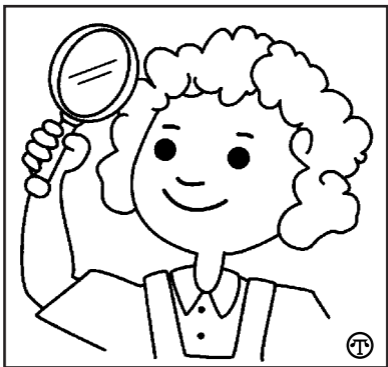


Free Read-Along Book For Kids
