A Sheer And Practical Solution For Windows



Here's a bright idea: A new sheer window treatment provides you with light control and privacy at the touch of a button.

(NAPSA)—Imagine being able to direct your room's view to the right or left, and block harsh sunlight as the day progresses with the touch of a button. In the evening, the same small button allows you to position this unique window covering to provide privacy from neighbors.

This is now made possible with the introduction of a motorized remote control system that works with Luminette<sup>®</sup> Privacy Sheers. Featuring soft fabric sheers with rotating fabric vanes attached to the rear for varying degrees of light control and privacy, Luminette sheers can now boast effortless operation. The motorized system, known as PowerGlide<sup>™</sup>, traverses the sheers and rotates the vanes with just a flick of a finger on the hand-held remote.

The window treatment can be made as large as 12 feet wide and 10 feet high, generous enough to cover an entire wall of windows in most rooms. It is available in five sheer fabric choices—from an elegant traditional sheer to the look of fine-spun muslin—and a soft, subtle palette. You can even buy the sheer fabric by the yard to make coordinating swags and valances as well as accessories. The fabric vanes are a neutral white for a consistent view from the exterior, and there is a room-darkening option available.

Luminette with PowerGlide does not require complicated wiring, but operates with any standard outlet. Moreover, you don't have to search for fancy, hard-to-find batteries. Two standard AAA batteries power the remote control. It would take a detective to spot the small satellite eye that can be mounted inconspicuously above the headrail on either the left or right side. The motor is mounted on the headrail, which resembles a drapery rod, and is hidden by the fabric header.

Just in case you misplace your remote, the sheers can be operated using a manual control button next to the infrared on the satellite eye. Perhaps best of all, this system has no dangling cords that can harm children or pets.
