A Kit Created To Silence Squeaky Floors

2) The next step is to place your weight around the fixture and drive the screw down into the floor as far as the fixture allows.



1) The first step in silencing a squeak is finding the joist. The kit comes with a tool designed for the job. Then, push the alignment and depth control fixture—also from the kit—into the carpet.



3) The final step is to place the gripper, which comes in the kit, over the head of the screw. Rock the screw until the head breaks off just below the surface of the floor, quieting the squeak.
