Workforce Is Investing In America's Job Bank

(NAPSA)—Now there's an Internet job bank that is free and lists job openings and offers resumés that are searchable online.

This new online resource is called America's Job Bank. It's a public/private partnership effort led by the U.S. Department of Labor (www.ajb.org) where employers looking for new people post their job openings and people looking for new jobs list their resumés.



America's Job Bank benefits employers and job seekers.

Job openings listed come from every state and span the entire economy with listings from major corporations as well as small businesses.

America's Job Bank is one of four online workforce tools in a family of Web sites called America's Career Kit. The other tools are America's Career InfoNet (www.acinet.org), which provides valuable information on employment trends, wages and career options; America's Learning eXchange (www.alx.org), which connects employers and job seekers to information on training and education resources; and America's Service Locator (www.service locator.org), which helps workers and employers find the career and workforce services they need.

Each month, America's Career Kit hosts seven million user sessions by job seekers and employers. It's considered the nation's most powerful online career development resource.
