

Tree Farmer, Rock Star And Man Of STIHL

(NAPSA)—Rock music and tree farming don't often go together, but these two disparate careers continue to fill the days of Chuck Leavell—and he continues to excel at both.

Leavell is widely known in rock-and-roll circles as a key-boardist who has toured with the Rolling Stones, Eric Clapton, George Harrison and the Allman Brothers. At the same time, Leavell has made his name within the tree-farming industry, dedicating his efforts to forest management and conservation.

"Chuck is always talking about trees on tour," said Mick Jagger. "But his passion for forestry is undeniable, and he's made some strong contributions to the environment through that passion."

Since the 1970s, Leavell has sharpened his forestry fervor while honing his musical talent. He studied forestry by correspondence while touring with The Fabulous Thunderbirds in the mid-1980s. In addition, he and his wife have turned her family's 2,200-acre tree farm—Charlane Plantation, near Macon, Ga.—into an award-winning pine forest plantation, a conservation educational facility and a wildlife hunting preserve.

Leavell has received numerous accolades for his tree-farming efforts. He is the only two-time recipient of the Georgia Tree Farmer of the Year Award and was named National Outstanding Tree Farmer of the Year in 1999. He has also partnered with STIHL Inc., the worldwide manufacturer of chain saws, on a number of high-profile initiatives in the forestry industry.
