Meistrich is also founder of Shooting Gallery and creator of the Shooting Gallery Film Series, which many describe as "groundbreaking."

Annual membership to the subscription service is \$19.95 per month or \$189 for the year, including shipping and handling.

Each feature film is accompanied by an original short film as well as director's notes, background information, cast bios, reviews and a list of awards to enrich the viewing experience.
