Chin-Up Decorating That Brings A Smile To Your Home

In the home of an over-achieving, very serious executive, the painter included a tiny teddy bear in a scene otherwise depicting a Grecian garden. The client loved the incongruity," she reports. "Although it has to be pointed out to be noticed, the executive knows it's there and it always makes her smile."

Collections and posters are vehicles that Maureen Petke, owner of Atlanta's Design & Décor, uses to add a lighthearted touch. One client had a Betty Boop cookie jar, hidden in a cupboard. Petke persuaded her to place it on a prominent kitchen shelf. She found a Betty Boop poster to hang beside it. "Together the two pieces are deliberately whimsical," Petke explains.

"Matte and frame cartoons and hang them up. When the joke loses its effect, replace it," Petke advises.

"Decorating should be personal and a reflection of who you are, including what makes you laugh," she contends. It's easy to replace yesterday's humorous cartoon, framed phrase or funny poster if you've hung them with self-stick mounting products with Command adhesive from 3M.
