Liberty Safe, for instance, offers safes that are rated to protect most items and documents from a typical 1,200-degree house fire for up to 2.5 hours.

Theft

Police say that most home robberies are of the "smash and grab" variety, where thieves get their job done in 10 minutes or less. Safes can help deter these crimes.

Experts say to look for safes with extra layers of hard metal behind the door combination lock to prevent drilling. You can also find top-of-the-line models from Liberty Safe that have ball bearings installed inside triple-layered metal plates. The ball bearings chew up drill bits, virtually eliminating forced entry. The safes are also made using a robotic-welded
