## Inexpensive Bathroom Makeovers

reduce noise and are fast and easy to install, requiring just four steps:

1. Remove old grille.
2. Remove old fan assembly.
3. Attach new fan and motor assembly to new motor plate.
4. Install new motor assembly and new grille.

The upgrade kits can boost air movement by about 20 percent and are up to 50 percent quieter, according to the manufacturer.
