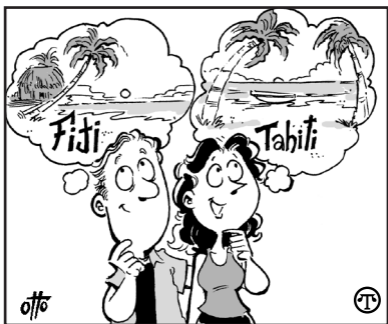


Tips On Trips
