Patrons of the Library of Congress talking-book program receive books at their door through the U.S. Postal Service. The talking-book program is a free library service for people who cannot see to read standard print or who cannot hold a book or turn pages. A variety of recreational reading materials is available including bestsellers, westerns, mysteries, romances, biographies, history, and other fiction as well as nonfiction. The equipment needed to read the books and magazines is also provided without charge.
