Fear Not. Growing Roses Is Easier Than Ever

Roses have been around for a long time. Confucius had a 600-book library on rose care. George Washington was the first person known to breed roses in the United States. Now there's a rose named after Ronald Reagan.

Walheim says, start with the basics:

- Choose well-adapted varieties for your area. A home center, garden shop or local chapter of the American Rose Society can steer you in the right direction.
- Plant in full sun and in welldrained soil.
 - Water during dry spells.
- Prune properly by removing dead, weak or decayed growth,

cutting back main canes, keeping the center of the rose bush open and removing crossing branches.

Fertilize regularly and protect against diseases and pests.
