TECH TOPICS: DON'T LOSE YOUR WI-FI IN THE DEAD ZONE

Your house may have dead zones where Internet devices can't get a good Wi-Fi signal—but you don't have to live with that. The experts at Milo-Wi-Fi say: Keep your router away from metal, and get the latest hardware. Wi-Fi routers broadcast over two frequencies, so when one is crowded, switch to the other.
