A PRIVATE, FULLY ACCREDITED COLLEGE IN DETROIT, THE COLLEGE FOR CREATIVE STUDIES EDUCATES ARTISTS AND DESIGNERS TO BE LEADERS IN CREATIVE PROFESSIONS. TO ENTER THE CONTEST, THE STUDENTS DESIGN A NEXT-GENERATION DODGE VEHICLE FOR THE YEAR 2025, AND INCLUDE A FIVE-HUNDRED-WORD ESSAY EXPLAINING WHAT THE DODGE BRAND MEANS TO THEM. THE DESIGNS MUST BE HAND DRAWN. THE FIRST-PLACE WINNER GETS THE SCHOLARSHIP—AS LONG AS HE OR SHE MEETS COLLEGE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS—A LAPTOP, A THREE-WEEK SUMMER AUTOMOTIVE DESIGN COURSE AND PASSES TO DETROIT AUTORAMA, CONSIDERED AMERICA'S GREATEST HOT ROD SHOW. THE SECOND- THROUGH FOURTH-PLACE WINNERS GET LAPTOPS OR TABLETS, A SUMMER COURSE AT C-C-S AND PASSES TO AUTORAMA. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY, JANUARY 23.
