SAFETY SENSE

SHOCKING AS IT MAY SOUND, EACH YEAR, THOUSANDS OF CHILDREN ARE INJURED WHEN THEY STICK ITEMS INTO ELECTRICAL OUTLETS. FORTUNATELY, THERE IS A WAY TO PROTECT CHILDREN FROM GETTING SHOCKED OR BURNED. TAMPER-RESISTANT RECEPTACLES, OR T-R-Rs, PROVIDE PROTECTION AGAINST THE INSERTION OF OBJECTS OTHER THAN CORD PLUGS INTO OUTLETS. THEY ARE SIMILAR IN APPEARANCE TO STANDARD WALL OUTLETS, BUT THEY FEATURE SPRING-LOADED COVER PLATES THAT CLOSE OFF THE RECEPTACLE SLOTS UNLESS EQUAL PRESSURE IS SIMULTANEOUSLY APPLIED TO BOTH SLOTS.
