When the weather's wet, it's wise to take special steps to prevent injury, even death, from electricity. For example, where outlets and electrical devices may be exposed to water, install Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters. These quickly shut off power to the circuit whenever they detect a leak in the current. Replace outdoor outlets with G-F-C-I receptacles or get a portable outdoor one for temporary needs.
