VETERAN NEWS AND NOTES

MANY ARE SURPRISED TO LEARN WHAT A FULL LIFE A VETERAN WITH A DISABILITY CAN LEAD. FOR EXAMPLE, STEVE BASKIS IS A TWENTY-SEVEN-YEAR-OLD VETERAN WHO IS PURSUING A COLLEGE DEGREE, HAS TAKEN UP MOUNTAIN CLIMBING—AND IS BLIND. RECENTLY, ON BEHALF OF B-V-A AND OTHER BLINDED VETERANS, HE VISITED WITH MEMBERS OF CONGRESS TO REQUEST ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR COMBAT-RELATED EYE TRAUMA RESEARCH. HE'S ALSO PARTICIPATED IN PROJECT GEMINI, A PROGRAM THAT LINKS BLINDED VETS IN THE U-S WITH THOSE IN THE U-K. TO LEARN MORE, VISIT B-V-A--DOT--ORG.
