- Look closely at tire tread and replace tires that have uneven wear or insufficient tread.
- Make sure you have enough coolant, oil, brake fluid and windshield washer fluid.
- 5. Have a mechanic check your battery and charging system.
- 6. Check your headlights, brake lights, turn signals, emergency flashers, and interior lights.
